





Memory Seat Position Saving

- Adjust the seat position using the powered seat adjustment controls
- Press the button M
- Press 1,2, or 3 button within the next 3 seconds
- You will hear a chime, indicating that the position is saved





Recalling Memory Seat Position

- Close the Door
- If the ignition is OFF Press either 1,2 or 3 to recall the position saved in it. The seat will move to the saved position
- If the ignition is ON Long Press either 1,2 or
 3 until the seat moves to the saved position
- You will hear a chime, indicating that the position is restored




ORVM Adjustment

- The ORVM Adjustment lever is located on the driver door pad
- The joystick can be turned to select left or right mirror
- The joystick can be moved to any side to adjust the mirror accordingly







Again, the washer fluid is sprayed for 1.5 seconds and wipers function for 3 times







- 3. Plug in your Echo device to a power outlet
- 4. Go to Devices section in your Alexa and follow the on screen instructions to add your Echo device and give it a name (Bedroom, Kitchen etc)
- 5. Login into the same Amazon account on the XUV700 infotainment screen
- 6. Your Alexa devices & XUV700 is connected to your Amazon account




















